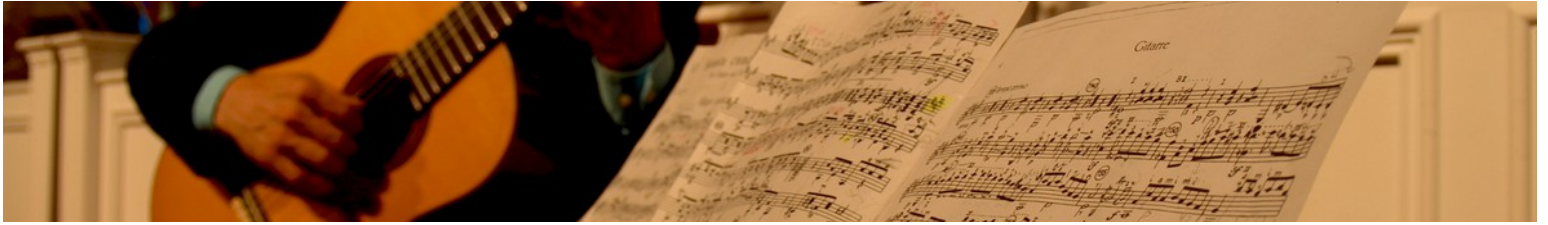


## Gregory Guay, classical guitar

### Biography

Guitarist Gregory Guay founded and performs for Charleston's *Holy City Guitar Series*. He has performed in the Guitar Foundation of America Festival, Piccolo Spoleto Festival, various university settings and in prestigious ensembles such as the *Charleston Symphony Orchestra*, *Charleston Gospel Choir*, and the latin group, *Caja de Cuerdas*. Gregory received his Masters Degree in Classical Guitar at Appalachian State University and his Bachelors and Artist Certificate at College of Charleston receiving scholarship and awards for Instrumental Excellence. His guitar talents and versatility range from Bach to Beatles; traditional Spanish/Latin works to modern improvisation and composition. He founded *LowCo Suzuki Guitar Studio* in Mount Pleasant, SC where he teaches classical guitar.
